The job duties will include:

- Contacting hunters to be surveyed (at least 100 per community)
- Communicating the purpose of the study and answering questions (training will be provided)
- Survey hunters
- Record information on data sheets
- Ensure accuracy of data collected
- Entering the data collected into a spreadsheet
- Sending information to coordinator
- Maintaining regular communication with Project Coordinator (via email, telephone)

Field workers must have:

- Excellent communication skills
- Strong work ethic and motivation
- Ability to work independently
- Ability to maintain confidentiality
- Access to email and phone
- Available to work during the term of the contract starting immediately and for 4 weeks
